Parent Consultations

At this time of year, we would normally provide time for parents/carers to speak to their children's keyworkers to discuss how their child has settled in nursery. However due to government restrictions we have had to find an alternative way to do it this year.

We will therefore be providing telephone consultations lasting 10 minutes per family.

Each group has a time slot when your child's key worker could potentially ring you. If you cannot be contacted the first time they ring, they will call you back at a later time.

This call will be a good opportunity for you to ask any questions that you may have and also to discuss how your child is getting on in nursery with their keyworker.

Coronavirus

It is especially important that we monitor all children's absence to nursery. Please could parents ring to inform the office if your child will be absent from nursery for any reason. Any messages left on an answering machine will be picked up by nursery.

Please can we remind parents to maintain a 2m distance at all times. We also kindly ask that parents refrain from standing in social groups.

Parents are reminded that children **must not come** to nursery if their child *or anyone* in the household has symptoms of coronavirus.

If anyone in the setting has symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19): a high temperature, new and persistent cough or a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia), however mild, they should self-isolate for at least 10 days from when their symptoms started and engage with NHS Track and Trace.

Please inform nursery immediately of any Covid test results. If your child receives a positive test result over the weekend, when nursery is closed, the best way to contact us would be via email:

If we need to contact all parents quickly, this will be done via a text message through our parentpay text message service.

Therefore, if you have not already signed up to this, please contact the office if you need further login details or support.

If someone tests negative, and they feel well and **no longer have symptoms** similar to coronavirus (COVID-19), they can stop self-isolating. They could still have another virus, such as a cold or flu – in which case it is still best to avoid contact with other people until they are better.
