



Do you want to go on a bear hunt?

Can you hide a bear in the garden for your child to find? This could be on a walk also. How are they going to get it down if stuck up high in a tree?

Discuss ways and encourage problem solving. This may include mathematical language: prepositions, height, length etc



Find out about bears. What types of habitat do they live in? What do they eat?

Look at the different places that the family can explore together? Can you think of similar locations near to where you live?

Make a simple map of the area where you live. You can follow the map together to find a bear that you have hidden in a location on your map...

Make a list of things that you might need if you were going on a Bear hunt with your family. Let your child see you writing...writing is a skill that children rarely get to see in a world full of texting...
